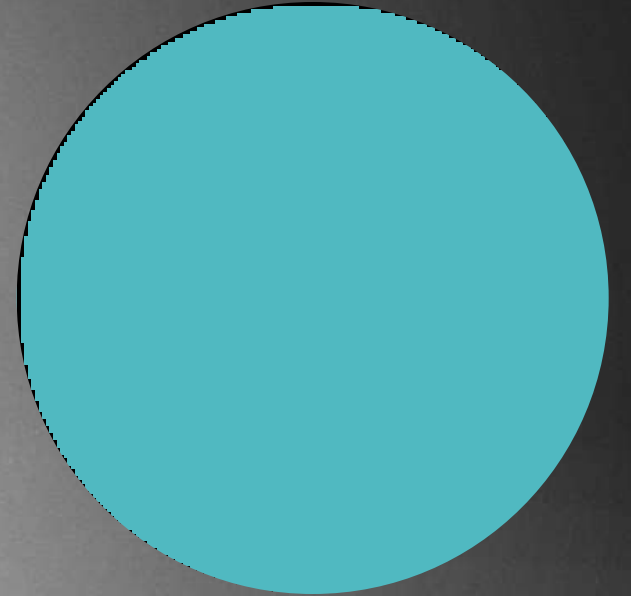


Mother Teresa

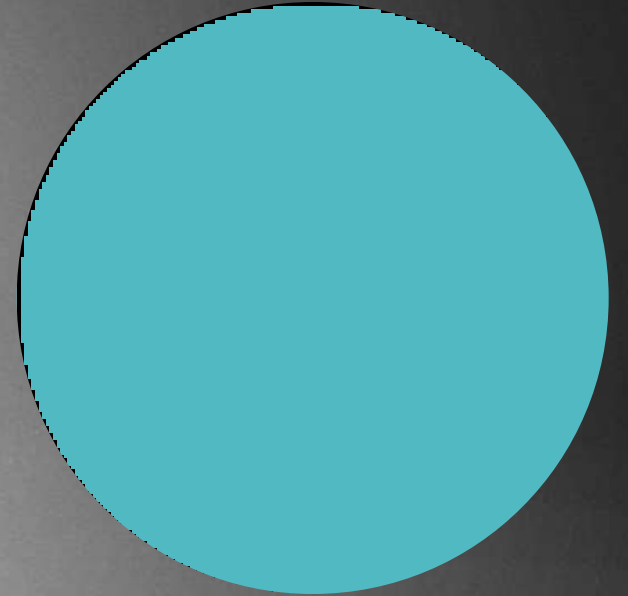


Mother Teresa giving a speech
