- Syros is a Greek island in the Aegean Sea.

Ermoupoli

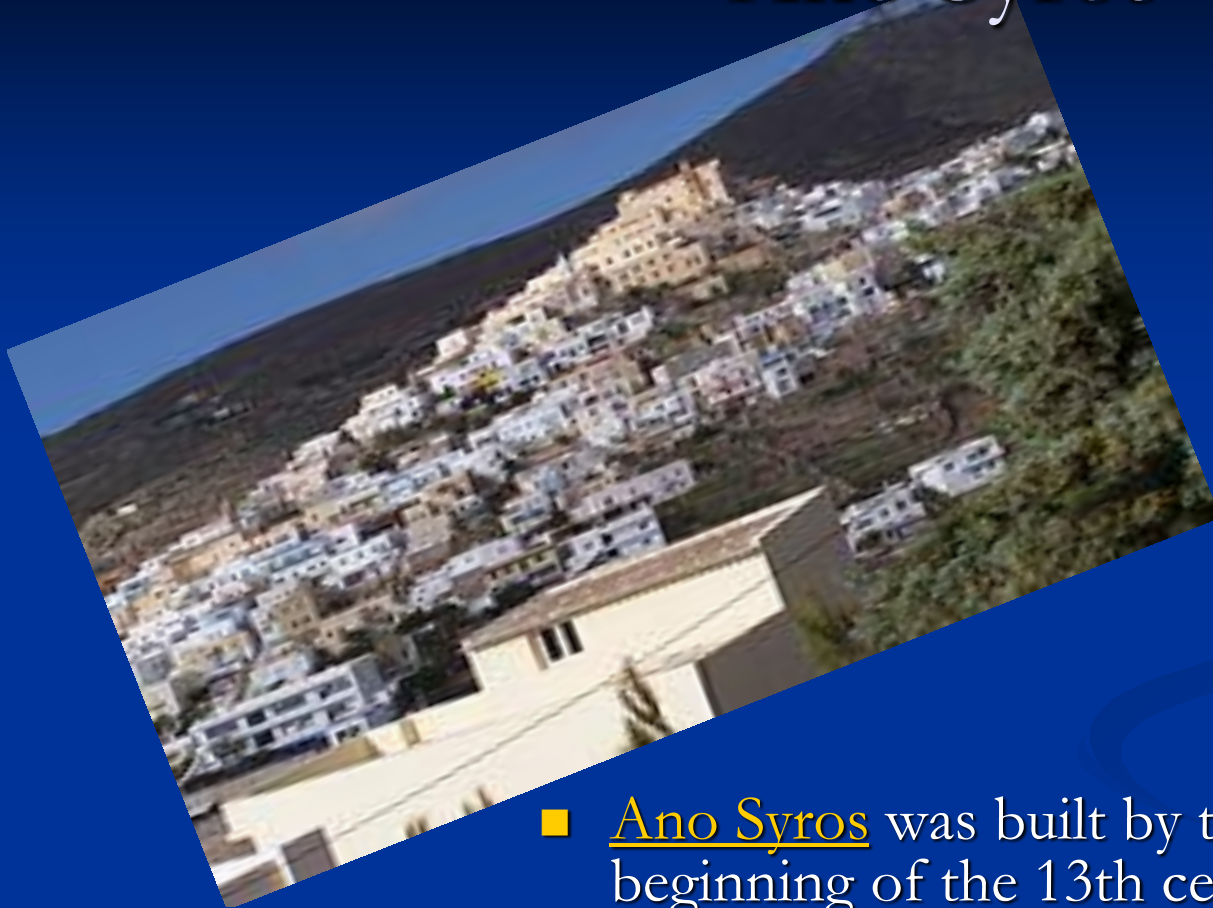
- Ermoupoli stands on a naturally amphitheatrical site, with neo-classical buildings, old mansions and white houses cascading down to the harbour. The City Hall, where Miaoulis Square lies ringed with cafes and with seating areas under palm trees.



- The Archaeological Museum has many exhibitions and the Municipal Library contains numerous editions.
- The quarter of the town known as Vaporía is where the sea captains lived. Along its narrow streets, stand numerous neo-classical mansions.



Ano Syros



- Ano Syros was built by the Venetians at the beginning of the 13th century on the hill of San Giorgio, north-west of Hermoupolis. Ano Syros maintains a medieval atmosphere. Innumerable steps between narrow streets and houses with coloured doors lead to the top of the town.

- The cathedral church was constructed during the 13th century. From the cathedral visitors have a panoramic view of the neighbouring islands of Tinos, Delos, Mykonos, Paros, Andros and Naxos.
