- It is located 78 nautical miles south- east of Athens.




Ermoupoli

Ermoupoli stands on a naturally amphitheatrical site, with neo-classical buildings, old mansions and white houses cascading down to the harbour. The City Hall, where Miaoulis Square lies ringed with cafes and with seating areas under palm trees.




- The Archaeological Museum has many exibitions and the Municipal Library contains numerous editions.
- The quarter of the town known as <u>Vaporia</u> is where the sea captains lived. Along its narrow streets, stand numerous <u>neo-classical</u> mansions.





The cathedral church was constructed during the 13th century. From the cathedral visitors have a panoramic view of the neighbouring islands of Tinos, Delos, Mykonos, Paros, Andros and Naxos.
